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
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The Hudson River GOLD COAST



A neighborhood with pedigree. The Hudson River Gold Coast was born on the land of Greystone on Hudson and has been the address of choice for America's most venerable families since the nineteenth century. The string of magnificent private estates stretching from Greystone on Hudson to the Rockefeller compound Kykuit gained the name "Millionaire's Row" and encompassed many of the most opulent homes of Westchester's golden age of high society, including Gould's neighboring Lyndhurst Castle and the surrounding Astor, Morgan, and Lehman manors.

The historic Greystone mansion was a regal Italianate stone castle and, for a century, was the family home of several of America's most prosperous families, including John D. Rockefeller's business partner and a founder of one of the original twelve Dow Jones Industrial members. Today this revered site, surrounded by the Hudson River and two thousand acres of permanently preserved parkland, has been transformed into Greystone on Hudson.


Just thirteen miles north of Manhattan and set within two thousand acres of lushly forested preserve with breathtaking views of the Hudson River.

The custom-built baronial estates combine old-world craftsmanship with state-of-the-art technology, within a private gated enclave with twenty-four-hour personalized doorman and concierge service for the comfort of residents and their guests.

Ideally located in one of the country's most historic corridors, at the waterfront Westchester town of Irvington, Greystone on Hudson is a pastoral escape that is perfectly accessible not only to the world's most influential center of business and culture, but also to the country's finest schools and a host of exceptional destinations for recreation, shopping, and fine dining.



Inspired by the original design of the gatehouse for Greystone Castle, the stone and wood detailed structure is framed by flickering gas-lit lanterns.






The winding Carriage Trail meanders up the hillside through preserved allées of century-old specimen trees.




At Greystone on Hudson, the view of your neighbor is a magnificent vista of Tarrytown Castle, the former private residence of prominent businessman General Howard Carroll.

A Philosophy of CRAFTSMANSHIP



The development team is dedicated to creating homes designed for memories that last a lifetime. The Greystone Mansion Group is an elite division of R3 Investment Partners dedicated to developing communities constructed with old-world craftsmanship, timeless design, and the pursuit of architectural perfection on elite and prestigious properties in New York, Connecticut, and the Hamptons. The management team has hundreds of years of combined experience in building and developing high-end estates and communities. Today, they have drawn on their vast expertise to create their finest masterpiece in Greystone on Hudson. We asked the principals of Greystone Mansion Group to share some insights around the creation of this extraordinary residential enclave.

Q & A with THE GREYSTONE MANSION GROUP



Q: Greystone on Hudson is situated in a remarkable setting. What influenced the design philosophy for the estates?

A: As soon as we first passed through the gates of Greystone, we felt this was the most incredible place we had ever seen, and we had to be the ones to restore it to its natural beauty. We were captured by the magical views and the grand history of the location. It is literally surrounded by castles, the family homes of some of the nation's most important industrialists, constructed over the past hundred and fifty years. Our design and level of craftsmanship is a tribute to the legendary neighboring Gilded Age mansions.

Q: There is an extraordinary element of privacy between the estates. How was the site plan determined?

A: We joke that Mother Nature was our lead designer. The different plateaus of Greystone on Hudson ensure that each estate is not only separated by the expanse of its own two- to five-acre terrain, but also by a substantial difference in elevation from each neighboring property. These unique variations in height create exceptional privacy and views, with the highest elevations over four hundred fifty feet above the river.

Q: One of the most breathtaking features of the site is the painterly view. River, bridge, forest preserves, ravines, and castles... all thirteen miles

from Manhattan. How did the natural landscape shape the design of each estate?

A: We spent a lot of time studying the landscape and thinking about the needs of our homeowners. The floor plans and outdoor spaces have been carefully considered to take advantage of the beauty of the breathtaking vistas, pastoral landscape, and natural light. Every estate forms its own unique compound with rolling hills and verdant lawns that can accommodate swimming pools, tennis courts, and entertainment pavilions with fire pits and outdoor audio/visual screens. We are very fortunate to have the Hudson River situated directly to our west, so verandas and sweeping terraces have been situated to accommodate fabulous parties to watch the spectacular multi-colored sunsets that occur over the Hudson River every single day.

Q: You mentioned that Greystone on Hudson was created in the spirit of the Gilded Age in terms of quality and craftsmanship. Can you discuss some of the construction techniques?

A: The team was inspired by immersing themselves in the history of the site, studying both the architecture and the modes of construction. Residences are united by cornerstone constructed from Manhattan Schist, an indigenous bedrock that is being quarried and pillowed on-site in the same manner used to build the historic

Greystone Castle and the area's seminal stone walls. We actually created our own artisan quarry on-site. This Schist that formed Greystone on Hudson's landscape is iconic as it was left behind by the same glacier that formed the rock outcroppings arising throughout Manhattan's Central Park. Besides being respectful of the history, we also wanted to look forward. An example of the state-of-the-art engineering at Greystone on Hudson is that energy-efficient lighting and geothermal heating and cooling have been deployed to protect our environment, virtually eliminate winter fuel bills, and greatly reduce summer cooling bills.

Q: The investment in the finishes is unprecedented for a new development. Belgian Bluestone is usually reserved for interiors due to the expense. Yet at Greystone on Hudson, sweeping verandas feature this imported stone hand-laid in a French pattern. What are other finishing highlights?

A: Our goal has been to design and construct the finest collection of homes ever created. The quality and detailing of the millwork, including moldings, wainscoting, paneling, and custom cabinetry throughout, are inspired by the finest turn-of-the-century estates in America and the English countryside. Kitchens are appointed with top-of-the-line Sub-Zero and Wolf appliances. There is radiant heated flooring throughout the kitchens and baths, with fine hardwood

and natural stone floors. Master baths have steam showers, body sprays, rain heads, fireplaces, with all the details carefully thought through. Our smart homes are designed so that at a touch of a button you can turn on every light in the house, or control your heating and cooling from your cell phone. We are designing and building to standards of craftsmanship, space planning, structure, soundproofing, waterproofing, and comfort to make these homes of style and substance built to be passed down for generations to come.

Q: The flow and proportions of each estate are grand and dramatic. What is the vision behind the layouts?


A: We understand the lifestyle of the prospective owners; therefore, we want to create estates that are designed for entertaining and family living on a grand scale. Each home is enhanced by a series of architectural highlights, including stately hardwood-paneled libraries, cinematic sweeping staircases, intimate piano alcoves, and abundant old-world mahogany windows composed to flood the home with natural light. The degree of spaciousness is epic; the master closets are the size of some whole Manhattan apartments. Then you have indoor entertainment spaces that are really just incredible at-home escapes. There's actually no need to leave the home—it's all within your reach.

CUSTOMIZED BY DESIGN

The façade of each estate is individually crafted with finishing elements inspired by the surrounding historical mansions. The collection of estates is aesthetically united by a tradition of detail.




CRAFTSMANSHIP DETAILS



PILLOWED STONE

The indigenous and iconic “Greystone” is quarried and hand pillowed on-site by skilled artisans.



BELGIAN BLUESTONE FLOORING

An exquisite level of detail is being applied to the outdoor living spaces. The spacious verandas that overlook the forest and river settings are often clad in this imported stone that is being hand laid in a french pattern.



HERRINGBONE FLOORING

The layout and application of the hand-scraped hardwood flooring is inspired by the interiors of the surrounding heritage estates.



CUSTOM WINDOWS

The custom windows, which flood your environment with spectacular natural light, are hand crafted with heavy natural mahogany sashes, creating deep texture and shadow lines on muntin bars with historical profiles. Updated with the modern technology of double insulated Low-E glass with Argon fill, they allow for maximum comfort and energy efficiency in every room.



DETAILED MILLWORK

The surrounding Gilded Age mansions inspire the quality and detailing of the millwork, including moldings, wainscoting, paneling, and finely finished cabinetry throughout.




FIREPLACES

Town & COUNTRY



Greystone on Hudson's iconic location borders Lyndhurst Castle and its spectacular Hudson RiverWalk, as well as two thousand acres of protected nature preserves including Rockefeller State Park, the Old Croton Aqueduct, and Taxter Ridge Preserve, encompassing hundreds of miles of hiking, biking, and riding trails following the river all the way to New York City. Sunset viewing parties on your veranda can be followed by a scenic walk along the Old Croton Aqueduct to Irvington's top restaurants. Choice clubs include the legendary Sleepy Hollow Country Club (three miles away), Ardsley Country Club (two miles away), and Westchester Country Club (twelve miles away). Less than ten minutes away is one of America's most prestigious malls, The Westchester, anchored by Neiman Marcus. Nearby is the treasured gastronomic destination Blue Hill at Stone Barns, rated among the top fifty dining establishments in the world. The town of Irvington offers stylish tranquility, elegant independent retailers, and one of several nearby Metro-North stations with direct access to Grand Central Station in approximately one half-hour. For more far-flung excursions, Westchester County Airport is within a fifteen-minute drive, with LaGuardia Airport just thirty minutes from home.


The quaint riverfront towns of the Hudson River Gold Coast offer a celebrated collection of farm-to-table dining destinations.


